FURTHER LANE CHANGES AT SH1 PAHUREHURE INLET TO PAKAKURA INTERCHANGE

Changes southbound Pahurehure Inlet to Papakura Interchange

- Full overnight motorway closures – SH1 from Takanini Interchange to Papakura Interchange from Tuesday 14 February to Thursday 16 February from 9pm-5am.
- Narrowed lanes and 80km/h speed limit, southbound from Pahurehure Inlet to Papakura Interchange, from Wednesday 15 February for approximately a year.

Changes northbound Papakura Interchange to Pahurehure Inlet

- Full overnight motorway closures – SH1 from Papakura Interchange to Takanini Interchange from Sunday 19 February to Tuesday 21 February from 9pm-5am.
- Narrowed lanes and 80km/h speed limit, northbound from Papakura Interchange to Pahurehure Inlet, from Monday 20 February for approximately a year.

The full overnight motorway closures are to enable the line marking of new, slightly narrowed traffic lanes southbound and northbound between Papakura Interchange and Pahurehure Inlet. A new work zone will be installed in the median to provide a safe working space to undertake project works. Lanes will be reduced in width from 3.5m to 3.25m.

This is similar to the work areas now in place from north of Orams Road to Pahurehure Inlet.

The signposted detours are via Great South Road (maps attached).

Line marking is weather dependent as dry conditions are needed. If it rains, work will be postponed until the next available dry night.

Drivers are advised to follow the signposted detour during night closures. During the day, we ask that motorists slow down and drive through the work areas with care.

Temporary traffic changes will be ongoing along the Southern Corridor as the project progresses.
